

TEXOMA SAILING CLUB GRANDPAPPY POINT MARINA

NOTICE OF RACE THE UNREGATTA July 18, 2020



1. Rules

- **1.1.** This race will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, except as modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2. RRS Rule 26 is changed to allow for a "Le Mans" style start.
- **1.3.** RRS Rule 33 is changed to allow for movement of marks during a race.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- **2.1.** Participation is open to all keelboats, subject to PHRF handicapping.
- **2.2.** Single-handed boats will be allowed to compete.
- **2.3.** Boats may enter as PHRF Cruising or Leisure Fleets (In-mast furling main and/or a beam/draft ratio of <=39%). A minimum of two boats are required to form a fleet.
- **2.4.** PHRF handicaps will be established by the TSC Chief Handicapper.
- **2.5.** Boats are encouraged to register online. Participants may also register onsite at the TSC Clubhouse. Execution of a Liability Release Agreement shall be required. Registration will open approximately two weeks before the race.
- **2.6.** All boats are required to check in at the TSC clubhouse no later than 1030 prior to racing, even if the boat is pre-registered by mail or other means.

3. Fees

- **3.1.** Fees for TSC Members will be \$25 per boat.
- **3.2.** Fees for Non-Members will be \$30 per boat.

4. Schedule

4.1. The schedule for this day's racing is:

Socially Distanced Awards available on Clubhouse Deck approximately 30 minutes after the closing of any protest period.

Due to social distancing guidelines, there are no social activities planned after this event.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and at the Skipper's Orientation. If published in time, they may also be posted on the TSC website.

5. Venue:

- 5.1. Races will be conducted on the waters of Lake Texoma, with starting areas announced in each race day's Skipper's Meeting.
- 5.2. Grandpappy Point Marina is the location of the series harbor.

6. Courses:

- **6.1.** Fixed Mark courses are planned. Fleets and distances to be sailed will be announced at the Skipper's Orientation.
- **6.2.** There will be special maneuvers to be undertaken on each leg of the course.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. The Low Point Scoring System (RRS A4) will apply.
- 7.2. Handicaps established by TSC will be used to determine a boat's corrected time.
- 7.3. For TSC members only, this day's race results will be utilized for TSC Championship points.
- 8. Berthing: Boats requesting an overnight berth should contact Grand Pappy Marina for availability.

9. Awards

- 9.1. Boats in first, second or third place in the final standings in a Fleet shall receive an award. If 4 or less boats are entered in a Fleet only two awards will be given. If 2 or less boats are entered in a Fleet only 1 award will be given.
- 9.2. Awards presentation will be 30 minutes after the close of any protest period. Awards presentation will be a come and go by individual competitor.
