NOTICE OF RACE 2020 TOM WUNDERLICK CLASSIC September 5, 2020



Rules

- .1. The series will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, except as modified by the sailing instructions.
- .2. RRS Rules 26 and A3 are changed to allow for a modified starting sequence and a starting window.
- .3. RRS Rule 28 is changed to allow use of waypoints as marks of the course per Appendix WP.

Eligibility and Entry

- .1. Participation is open to all Keelboats, subject to PHRF handicapping.
- **.2.** Each boat shall carry no less than two persons aboard.
- **.3.** This race involves sailing during night-time hours. All boats must be equipped with working navigation lights, VHF radio, GPS and cell phone.
- .4. Boats may enter as PHRF Keelboat Cruising or Leisure Fleets (Leisure fleet is reserved for boats with in-mast furling main, wing keel and/or a beam/draft ratio of <=39%). A minimum of two (2) boats are required to establish a Fleet. Other fleets may be established at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- .5. PHRF handicaps and Fleet assignments will be established by the TSC Chief Handicapper.
- **.6.** Boats are encouraged to register online at www.texomasailingclub.org. Participants may also register onsite at the TSC Clubhouse. Execution of a Liability Release Agreement shall be required. Registration will open approximately two weeks before the race.

Fees

- .1. Fees for TSC Members will be \$25 per boat.
- .2. Fees for Non-Members will be \$30 per boat.

Schedule

The race is scheduled for September 5, 2020.

The traditional Sunday Breakfast and Awards Ceremony are cancelled due to club social distancing guidelines. Results will be posted by email to competitors approximately 30 minutes after the closing of any protest period and when scoring is completed. Socially Distanced Awards will be available for pick up by competitors by 0900 on Sunday, September 6.

• **Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration. If published in time, they may also be posted on the TSC website and emailed to registered competitors.

Venue:

- .1. Races will be conducted on the waters of Lake Texoma, with starting areas announced at the Skipper's Orientation.
- .2. Grandpappy Point Marina is the location of the series harbor.
- **Courses:** A course of 15-20 miles is anticipated as determined by weather conditions on Race Day. The course will be configured to enable boats to finish the course between 2000 hrs. and 2300 hrs.

Scoring

- .1. The Low Point Scoring System (RRS A4) will apply.
- .2. Handicaps established by TSC will be used to determine a boat's corrected time.
- .3. For TSC members only, individual race results will not be utilized for TSC Championship points.
- Berthing: Boats requesting an overnight berth should contact Grandpappy Marina for availability.

Awards

Socially Distanced Awards will be available for pick up by competitors by 0900 on Sunday, September 6.

FLEET WINNER TROPHIES - Boats in first, second or third place in the final standings in a Fleet shall receive an award. If 4 or less boats are entered in a Fleet only two awards will be given. If 2 boats are entered in a Fleet only 1 award will be given.
